Explore the barrier island beaches of Wallops and Assateague, the sand dunes and maritime forest of Savage Neck Dunes Natural Area Preserve, the salt marshes of Greenbackville, VA, and the Miocene age Calvert Cliffs where you can hunt for 8-11 million year old fossils and shark teeth.
